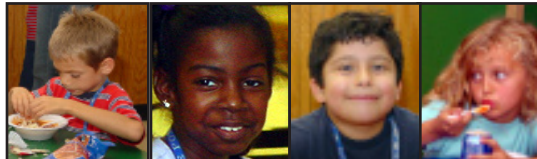

Kids Cafe

Kids Cafe programs provide free meals and snacks to low-income children through a variety of existing community locations where children congregate such as Boys and Girls Clubs, churches or public schools. Through Kids Cafe, at risk youth receive a hot nutritious meal every weekday, a meal they may not get without the program.

Kids Cafe Sites

Friendly House, Davenport

75 meals, 4 nights a week

Boys and Girls Club, Moline

100 meals, 5 nights a week

United Neighbors, Davenport

100 meals, 3 nights a week

MLK Center, Rock Island

75 meals, 4 nights a week



Why is Kids Cafe so Important to our Community?

13 million kids live in households that do not have an adequate supply of food 40% of all emergency shelter food recipients are children, even though they represent only 25% of the U.S. population Even mild under-nutrition experienced by children may lead to reductions in physical growth and affect brain development.



Poor nutrition can:

- Create behavior problems
- Shorten attention spans
- Contribute to poor academic achievement
- Lower energy levels
- Increase incidents of high blood pressure
- Aid in early onset of Type II Diabetes
- Contribute to overweight and obesity

River Bend Foodbank provided children in this community over 45,000 meals through Kids Cafe last year.



Through Kids Cafe, we hope to gain community support to reach more underserved youth as well as promote community awareness of the rising poverty level in the Quad Cities and surrounding areas.
